St. Kitts Music Festival always delivers lively music, delicious food, and great entertainment for an excellent price. In three nights you are immersed in soca, reggae, dance hall, r & b, and calypso, in addition to St. Kitts and Nevis indigenous "Wylers Music", a fast tempo blend of soca, reggae, and zouk music performed by Nu Vybes Band International on June 27th, and Small Axe Band on June 28th 2019.

The fun begins on June 26th with a party at Christophe Harbour Marina, and Escape Fete at Salt Plage on the South-East Peninsula, followed by three nights

of local, regional, and international live music, ending on Friar's Bay beach with White Sands at Carambola.

Traditionally held at the historic Warner Park Stadium, the 23rd St. Kitts Music Festival will be hosted this year at Kim Collins Athletic Stadium in Bird Rock, built in 2008. The stadium is named after St. Kitts world renowned Track and Field Sprinter Kim Collins who placed first in the mens100 meters at the IAAF World Championships in Saint Denis, France setting a 10.07 seconds world record on August 25th 2003. He also earned the title of being the first man over 40 to break the 10 seconds barrier establishing a master's record of 9.93 seconds, just one of his many athletic accomplishments.

Bird Rock has interesting places to keep you engaged. It is home to the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank, founded in 1983 to maintain currency stability of the Eastern Caribbean Dollar for OECS member states, which also houses the "Sir Cecil Jacobs Auditorium", a state of the art theatre named after the first Governor of the E.C.C.B. by the monetary council in 2002. Barry's Bar Grill and Entertainment Spot "Home of the Drinkin' Posse", is a local favourite for good food, karaoke, watching international sports, or socializing with friends and family over a friendly game of pool, ping pong, or darts. Bird Rock Beach Hotel offers comfortable facilities to rest your wary

self, and a variety of activities for water enthusiasts who enjoy swimming with the dolphins, snorkelling, and scuba diving to see colourful fish, live coral reefs, and sunken vessels surrounding St. Kitts island nooks.
